I. Call to Order – 7:00 PM

II. Responding to the roll call were Bill Svehla, Lindley Reubin, Wade Robson, Chuck Fiske, Ralph Edge and Carl Hill.

III. APPROVAL –

February 2026 Minutes

- A. Ordinance 26-01 re Accessory Dwelling Units-2nd Reading

 - 1. The new truck will be picked up in the near future. Cost: \$64,650.00.

- D. Building of New Maintenance Structure
 - 1. Preliminary plans are underway for building new maintenance structure.
- E. Hiring of New Police Personnel
 - 1. Chief Morton stated that we are still running the job opening with some possible good candidates.
- F. Recent Bad Weather
 - 1. Cncl Reubin brought up the recent rainstorm. This storm caused some water damage in the city limits obstructing some of the culverts with gravel. Also a portion of Elizabeth was damaged due to the storm. Rock will be added to shore up the road. The city will request assistance from the Grover Fire District to unplug the culverts.
- G. Restroom Located in Pavillon Area
 - 1. A new metal roof was installed on the restroom.
